

Loch Maree



Loch Maree is a thorn-free, early - mid season bramble with a sweet flavour.

Breeder: SCRI

Parentage: 81309C2 X 82417A12.

This variety is protected by an application for EU Plant Variety Rights.

Loch Maree is the latest blackberry cultivar to be released from SCRI. This is a thorn-free, high quality blackberry suitable for the fresh market. In addition to its high quality fruit, Loch Maree produces a spectacular pink double blossom, an attractive trait for the amateur grower.

Maturity: Loch Maree is an early-mid season blackberry about 7 days later than Loch Tay.

Market: Loch Maree is suitable for the fresh market and its spectacular double pink blossom also makes it an excellent choice for the amateur market.

Fruit Quality: Loch Maree fruit is glossy black with an excellent sweet and aromatic flavour. Fruit size is similar to Loch Tay.

Field Characteristics: Canes are semi-erect and thorn-free, making Loch Maree easy to manage. Fruit is presented very well for picking.
