



**General purpose swede with resistance to powdery mildew.**

**Breeder:** SCRI

This variety was added to the UK National List in 1991 and is protected by Plant Breeders' Rights.

**Agent:** Limagrain UK Limited (LG).

**Breeding:**

- Marian x (Regent x Broadland).
- Pedigree inbreeding with selection for yield and resistance to powdery mildew.
- Multiplication of F6 family to produce uniform inbred-line cultivar.

**Description:**

- Purple skin, cream flesh and intermediate (between globe and tankard) shape.
- High fresh yields at low dry matter content.
- Good resistance to powdery mildew.

**Cattle and Sheep:**

- High yields of fresh food throughout autumn and winter from May/June sowing.
- Graze in situ by sheep with electric fence to reduce wastage.
- Lift, store and feed (ideally chopped) to beef cattle.

**Culinary use:**

- Autumn and early winter.
- Recommend sowing Grade H seed with precision drill.
- Recommend covering with fleece or Wondermesh to control root flies.
