Very high yielding, purple skinned swede with white flesh and resistance to powdery mildew.

Breeder: SCRI

This variety was added to the UK National List in 1994 and is protected by Plant Breeders' Rights.

Agent: Limagrain UK Limited (LG).

Breeding:

- Line derived from Magres x Line derived from Criffel.
- Pedigree inbreeding to F₆ with selection for high dry-matter yield and powdery mildew resistance.
- Multiplication of F₆ family to produce uniform inbred-line cultivar.

Description:

- Pale purple skin, white flesh and intermediate (between globe and tankard) shape.
- Very high yields of fresh and dry-matter.
- Low to medium dry-matter content but moderate winter hardiness.
- Good powdery mildew resistance.

Cattle and sheep:

- High yields of fresh food throughout autumn and winter from May/June sowing.
- Graze in situ by sheep with electric fence to reduce wastage.
- Lift, store and feed (ideally chopped) to beef cattle.

Processing use:

- Can be used for processing as white fleshed.
