



Culinary swede which can also be fed to livestock.

Breeder: SCRI

This variety was added to the UK National List in 1997 and is protected by Plant Breeders' Rights.

Agent: Limagrain UK Limited (LG).

Breeding:

- Line from Criffel x Line from Marian.
- Single seed descent.
- Multiplication of F6 family to produce uniform inbred-line cultivar.

Description:

- Attractive deep purple skin and yellow flesh with globe shape of traditional shopping swede.
- Average yields of dry-matter at a low dry matter content.

Cattle and Sheep:

- Ideal for grazing between October and January.
- Graze in situ by sheep with electric fence to reduce wastage.
- Lift, store and feed to beef cattle.

Culinary use:

- Autumn and early winter.
- Recommend sowing Grade H seed with precision drill.
- Recommend covering with fleece or Wondermesh to control root flies.
