

Inca Bella potato



Specialist Phureja variety with rich nutty flavour.

Breeder: SCRI
Added to the UK National List in 2009.

Agent: Branston Ltd (www.branston.com).

Breeding: Mayan Gold x DB257(28)
DB257(28): diploid potato from SCRI's long-day-adapted population of Phureja potatoes.

Description: Maincrop
Long oval, yellow tubers with shallow large red eyes and yellow flesh.
Medium dry matter. Short dormancy.
Good resistance to bruising and splitting.

Disease and Pest Resistance:
Good resistance to dry rot (*Fusarium coeruleum*).
Good resistance to black dot, black scurf and skin spot.
Good resistance to common scab and powdery scab.

Main uses: Multi-purpose Phureja.
Ideal for salads.
Can be steamed, roasted and baked.
