**Phureja potato with excellent flavour.
Suitable as speciality salad variety.**

Breeder: SCRI

Breeding: 80CP23 x 71T46

80CP23: diploid potato from SCRI's long-day-adapted population of Phureja potatoes.

71T46: diploid potato from SCRI's long-day-adapted population of Phureja potatoes.

Description: Maincrop.

Long oval, white tubers with red eyes and yellow flesh.
Short dormancy.

Disease and Pest Resistance:

Good resistance to common scab.
Good resistance to potato virus Y^O.

Main uses: Speciality salad variety.
