**Phureja potato with good flavour.
Suitable for salad use.**

Breeder: SCRI

This variety was added to the UK National List in 2008 and is protected by EU Plant Variety Rights.

Agent: Greenvale AP (www.greenvale.co.uk).

Breeding: Open-pollinated diploid potato from SCRI's long-day-adapted population of Phureja potatoes.

Description: Maincrop.
Long oval, red and white (spectacle) tubers with yellow flesh plus some red areas.
Short dormancy.

Disease and Pest Resistance:
Good resistance to blackleg.
Good resistance to common scab and powdery scab.

Main uses: Pre-pack.
Ideal for a salad eaten either hot or cold with skins on.

Best steamed to preserve colour.
